- 3. Be informed about the world around you
- 4. Stay maximally informed and self-educate about complex issues
- 5. Make informed opinions and work to be an enlightened citizen
- 6. Pursue education and knowledge benefiting the community

PROVIDE INDIVIDUAL VALUE

- 1. Be a good parent, step or foster parent if you have children
- 2. Work, be self-sufficient, avoid relying on government
- 3. Be honest, trustworthy, responsible and compassionate
- 4. Provide leadership and take responsibility for your actions
- 5. Share and help shape your countries values

CHARITY AND SACRIFICE

- 1. Give back and helping others who are in need
- 2. Support, donate and volunteer w/charities and worthy causes
